You supply only the paint!



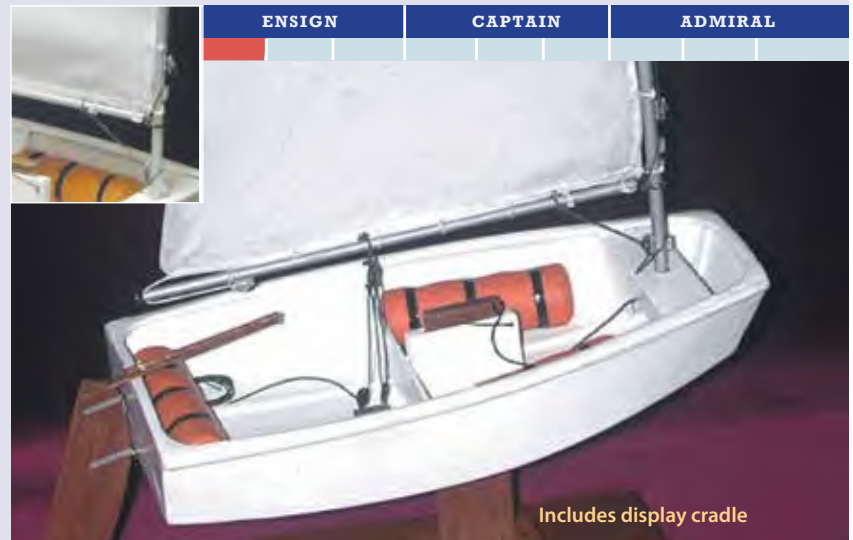

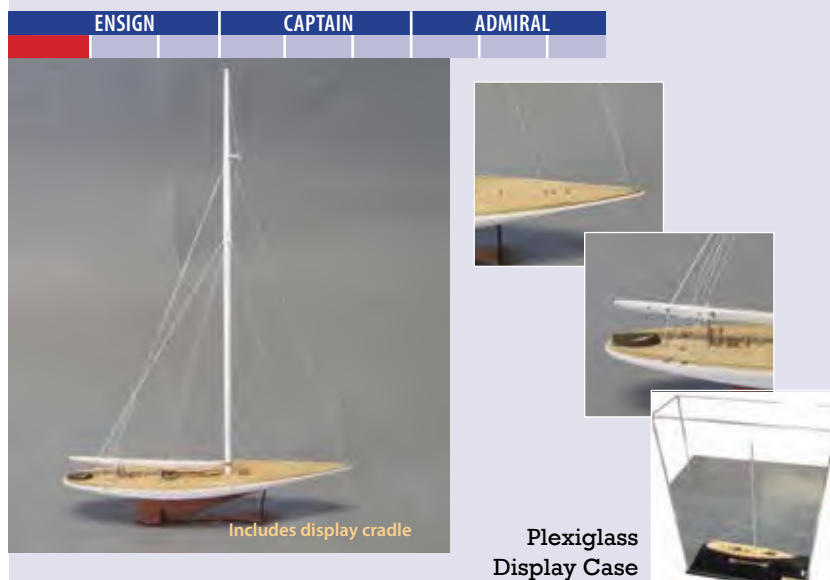

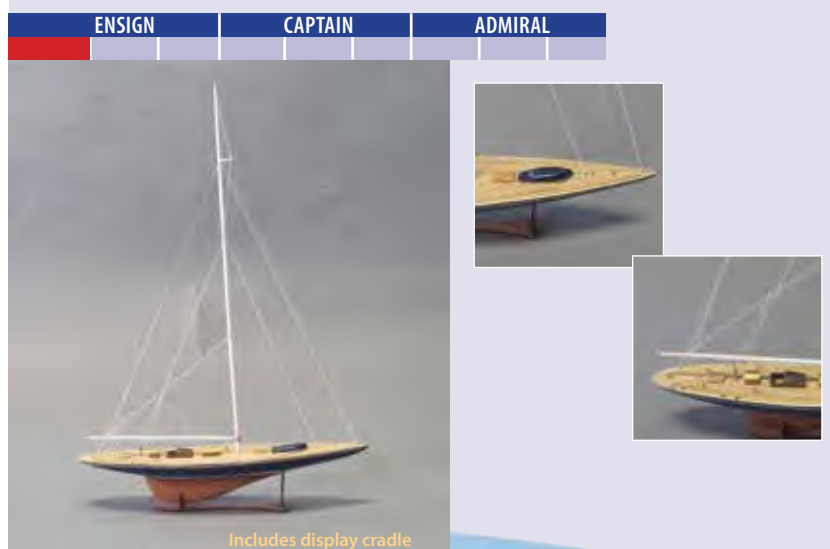

Rainbow was a William Starling Burgess design ordered by Harold Vanderbilt and built by the Herreshoff Manufacturing Company.

## **ENDEAVOUR** ITEM #K1108

*1934 America's cup runner up*

**LOA: 8 1/2" SCALE: 1:180 HEIGHT: 12"**

Endeavour was a 130-foot (40 m) J-class yacht built for the 1934 America's Cup by Camper and Nicholson in Gosport, England. She was built for Thomas Sopwith who used his aviation design expertise to ensure the yacht was the most advanced of its day with a steel hull and mast. She was launched in 1934 and won many races in her first season including against the J's Velsheda and Shamrock V. She failed in her America's Cup challenge against the American defender Rainbow but came closer to lifting the cup than any other until Australia II succeeded in 1983.

Immediately after the American Revolutionary War the United States was desperately needed strong enforcement of tariff laws. On 4 August 1790, Congress passed legislation authorizing the Revenue-Marine, a "System of Cutters". Ten vessels were initially ordered, constructed and assigned along the East Coast. On 28 January 1915, the service was merged with the United States Life-Saving Service to form the United States Coast Guard.

*The world's most popular One-Design keelboat*

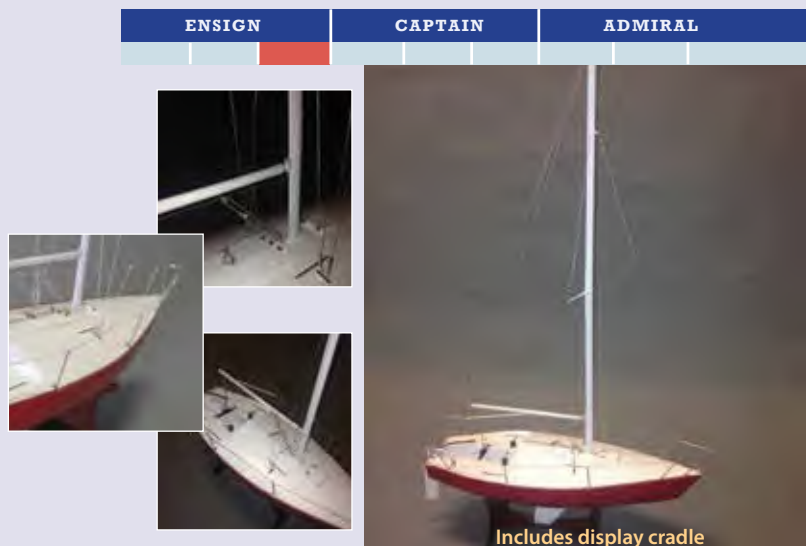

The J/24 class has more than 50,000 people sailing 5,300 boats worldwide. It is established in nearly 40 countries with well over 150 active fleets, and it is still considered the "gold standard" for modern one-design keelboats around the world. It features a solid carved wood hull, an airfoil-shaped aluminum mast and stainless steel photo-etched details. This beautiful model is a joy to build, and will be a welcome addition to a modeler's collection or in the home or office of a proud J/24 owner. The J/24 class kit is meant for modelers with upper Ensign skill levels, and comes complete with bending jigs for exceptional pulpit and stern rail accuracy.

## GRAND BANKS DORY

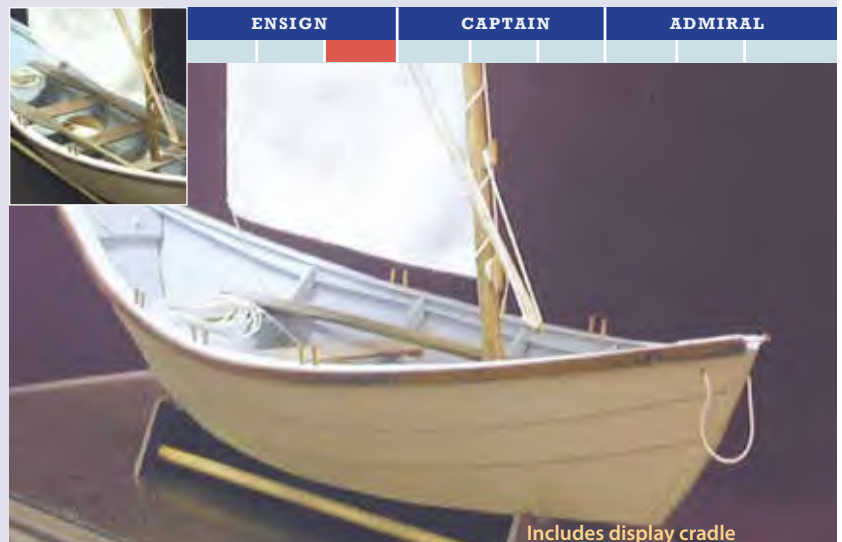
**ITEM #KLW102**

*A classic work boat*

**LOA: 16" SCALE: 1" = 1' HEIGHT: 13"**

Remember "Captains Courageous?" On the tumultuous seas of the Grand Banks off northern New England, hardy cod fishermen set their handlines from these seemingly fragile cockleshells. Returning to the mother schooner each evening, the dories were designed to nest one inside another on deck. Built exactly the same way as the full sized boat—triangular stern, flat bottom, and three garboard strakes—this kit is a true learning experience. The model can be displayed with the sail upright and unfurled, or in a furled and stowed position.

**pf** **SWAMPSCOTT DORY** ITEM #KLW114

**⚡** *A New England tradition*

**d** **LOA: 18"** **SCALE: 1" = 1'** **HEIGHT: 18 1/4"**

Swampscott dories were the most highly refined variant of the dory type ever built, making them the aristocrats of dories. Originally built for inshore fishing and lobstering along the coast of Massachusetts, their speed, ease of handling and low cost soon made them popular as recreational sailboats. Developed when clear pine boards were cheap and plentiful, the Swampscott dory had only four strakes (planks) to a side, saving labor and permitting rapid construction. Our model shares these characteristics—it is simple, quick to build, and makes a lovely display model. This is a good kit for the inexperienced builder.

*A sextant is a navigation instrument that measures the angular distance between two visible objects, primarily a star and the horizon for celestial navigation. The angle and the time when it was measured can be used to calculate a position line on a nautical chart.*

*The determination of this angle is known as sighting or shooting the object, or taking a sight.*

*A little different than the chartplotters of today!*



*In the vast expanses of the South Pacific during WWII, the accuracy of a young sailor's sightings could have been the difference between victory and defeat.*

Because of her large scale (1:24, or 1/2"=1'), every little detail has been meticulously replicated. Build the tryworks brick by brick using an inner shell with brick locations marked. The Morgan kit includes bottom copper plates, a template for rivet placement, and she can be finely detailed with treenails, etc.. She is engineered for success on a building jig. This kit features all the wood parts for plank-on-frame construction, cast Britannia fittings, laser-cut pieces, resin castings, photo-etched parts, and bottom copper plate.

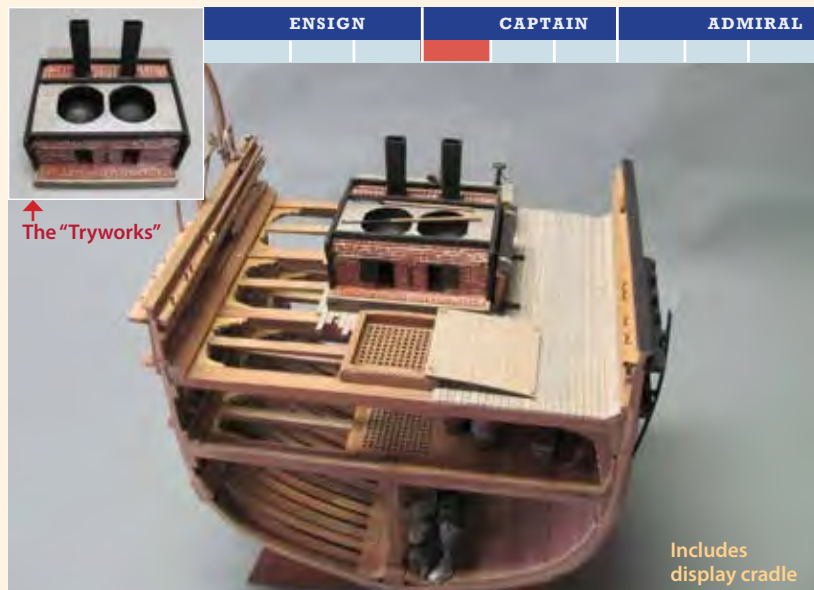

Designed by George Steers, who later made history as the designer of the most famous yacht in the world...AMERICA! Speed and maneuverability were of the essence for these purpose designed and built working boats. In order to receive a piloting commission, boats would race to be first to greet incoming ships entering New York Harbor. While this excellent solid hull model of a schooner is perfect for the less experienced builder, her graceful lines make her an interesting subject for any modeler.

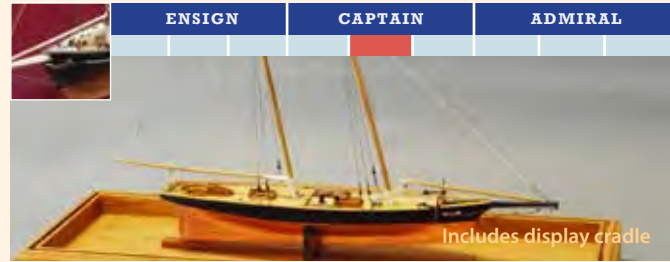

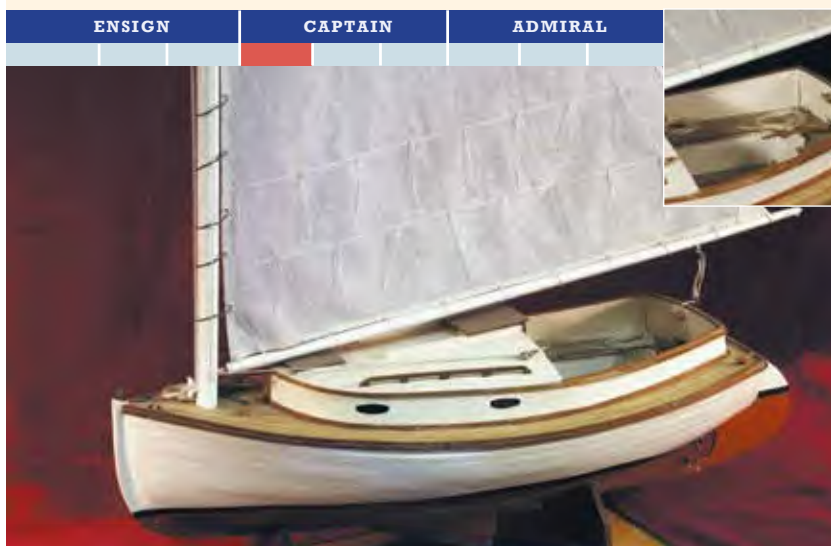
## WE'RE HERE ITEM #K1009

## CAPE COD CATBOAT

The catboat has been recognized as one of the true American boats. Its most successful version was developed for the difficult fishing and lobstering conditions along Massachusetts's Cape Cod. They worked as much as 30 miles offshore in shallow waters with strong tides. They had to be shoal draft, fast, seaworthy, weath-erly, and inexpensive. It was a tall order...but the catboat did it all and more. Catboats exist today as popular yachts. Our plank on bulkhead model, with laser cut basswood and mahogany parts, is a fine example of this purpose-developed boat.

Originally used to fish offshore on the Georges Banks, these classics have found popularity as small yachts. Our Friendship sloops are based on a typical 1900 design, and are available in two sizes. Both kits are plank on bulkhead and contain many laser cut parts. These models can be easily detailed and personalized. Remember, in modeling, bigger is usually easier.

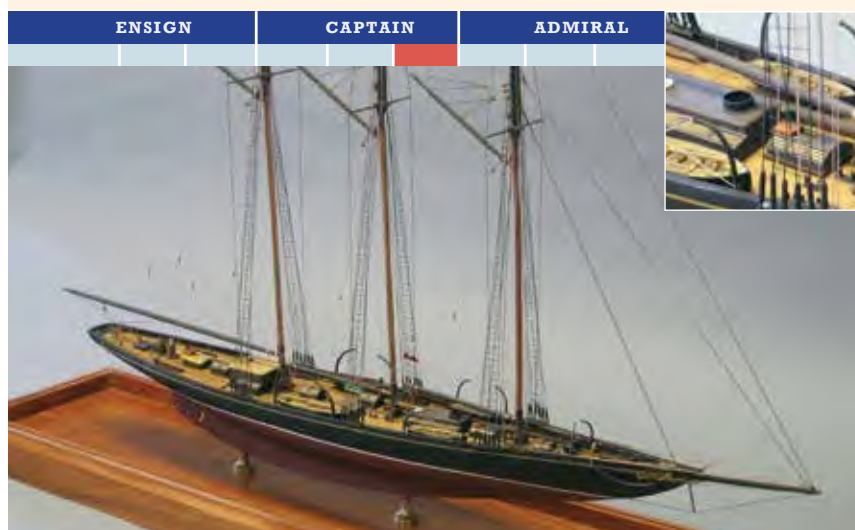

Trans-Atlantic record holder for 92 years. This sleek, black, three-masted vessel set a trans-Atlantic record in 1905, of 12 days, 4 hours, 1 minute, and 19 seconds, which was not beaten until 1997! This solid hull schooner epitomizes grace and sophisticated style. She is a striking and impressive model, suitable for a modeler with moderate experience. If you build the ATLANTIC, you will always look upon your model with pride.

## **FANNIE A. GORHAM**

*Typical Maine cargo schooner*

Launched in 1881 in Belfast, ME (just 8 miles from BlueJacket's home in Searsport), the GORHAM was built especially for the coastal trade, carrying lumber and other cargo from New England to southern ports. We have built a finished model of the GORHAM for the grandson of her commanding captain when she was "lost at sea, with all hands." FANNIE A. GORHAM is a good model for the intermediate builder and, with her off-center main mast, centerboard, and shallow draft, is an unusual and interesting subject for any modeler.

## **DARK HARBOR 17** ITEM #KLW152

*One of the most successful racing sloops*

**LOA: 27" SCALE: 1"=1' HEIGHT: 32 3/8"**

This classic design may be the oldest active racing sloop class in the U.S. Designed by B.B. Crowninshield in 1906, this boat's continuing popularity lies in her sleek hull form and the ability to outsail many modern designs. Named after Dark Harbor, Islesboro, Maine and still sailed there to this day. As supplied, the kit provides all the necessary parts to build a display model of the original gaff-rigged boat.

Capt. Joshua Slocum's account of his historic voyage in the SPRAY, *Sailing Alone Around The World* is one of the greatest adventure stories of all times. Sailing for 3 years in his rebuilt 100 year old oyster smack, Capt. Slocum's trip is regarded, even today, as being one of the most outstanding voyages in history. Due to the complexity of the hull shape and the extra-thick planking, this kit is recommended for modelers with plank on frame experience. Much of the wood is laser cut. All rigging line, Britannia fittings, and sailcloth are included.

## CHARLES P. NOTMAN ITEM

#K1894

*She's big, beautiful, and planked*

**LOA: 41" SCALE: 1/8"=1' HEIGHT: 20"**

NOTMAN was the first major vessel (1894) built at the famed Percy & Small Shipyard, Bath, Maine. With her schooner rig, long poop deck, short well deck forward of the mainmast, a forecastle deck, and a fine clipper-like bow entry, she epitomizes what we know as a "Downeaster".

to spanker boom tip, and the last six-masted schooner built on the east coast of the US.



# Half Hulls

## FOR THAT SPECIAL PRESENTATION

**HALF-HULLS** were originally used by shipwrights to develop the lines of a full-sized vessel, prior to construction. Once the designer was satisfied with the shape of the hull, shipwrights converted the final shape to the lines of the actual vessel through a process called lofting.

BlueJacket Shipcrafters offers both custom-built half-hulls and kits. Our custom half-hulls can have a traditional clear (also known as "bright") finish or can be fully painted, and are individually hand carved. A clear finished half-hull model can be constructed utilizing your choice of decorative woods. Frequently, alternating layers of different woods are used to show the lifts, or contrasting woods are used for the area above and below the waterline, all with a satin finished backboard designed to complement your model.



Painted models can be provided with details such as deck hardware, cabins, masts, bowsprits, hatches, ports etc. Even unique name graphics can be added on the side of the hull.

BlueJacket also provides half-hulls as part of commemorative or presentation awards, as well as both perpetual or individual trophies.

In response to many requests, BlueJacket has created half-hull kits that teach the modeler how to build in the traditional hand-carved "lift method". All half hull kits contain pre-cut lifts, a chamfered solid backboard, brass nameplate, plans, and illustrated instruction booklet. The modeler learns to glue the lifts, carve and sand them to conform to the true hull shape, finish the model and backboard, and assemble the completed model.

BlueJacket provides fine custom built cases and "case kits" to complement and protect your model. All of our cases are provided with native American cherry bases. The frames are supplied in your choice of either chamfered cherry wood or 1/4" brass. Completed cases are supplied with 1/8" plate glass and the wood is hand rubbed with a fine oil finish.

BlueJacket's "case kits" are offered to help offset the extremely costly shipping fees associated with completed cases. A "case kit" consists of a cherry base, your choice of either brass or cherry frames, and assembly instructions. All supplied wood in a "case kit" is finish sanded, but it is not finished. The bases are routed to accept 1/8" glass, but glass is not included in a kit. Many customers take the kit to a local glazier and request that he supply the appropriate glass and assemble the case.

Because our cases and "case kits" are custom manufactured to your specified dimensions, payment in full is required at the time of order. Also, please note that special shipping/handling charges apply. As a case size guide, while it is highly subjective, we normally suggest that the case size be 4" longer than the total length of the model, 3" wider, and 2" taller. Please note that all sizes discussed/written are interior dimensions, whether stated or not.

Due to their custom sizes, BlueJacket is not able to offer refunds on cases or case kits.

## TIPS ON PAINTING PEWTER

First, dip the part in a saucer of acetone or lacquer thinner to remove any skin oils; then dip it in thinned paint, shake to remove droplets, and let dry. Repeat if needed; two thinned coats of paint will not hide the details as much as a single thick coat.

Blocks were usually oil-treated to resist weathering, so dark brown is a good choice; dead-eyes and hearts were protected with tar, so make them black. 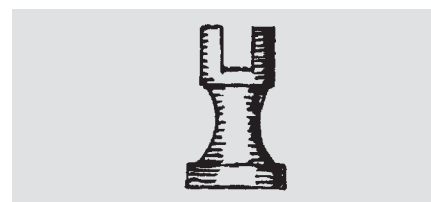
